SECTION 3: COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Fatty acid profile is provided in the Technical Data Sheet as typical composition. The fatty acids (oleic, linoleic, palmitic, lauric) are constituent parts of the natural triglyceride matrix and are not separate added ingredients.

SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation:

- Remove affected person to fresh air
- Keep at rest; seek medical advice if symptoms persist

Eye Contact:

- Rinse cautiously with water for at least 15 minutes
- Remove contact lenses if present and continue rinsing
- Seek medical advice if irritation persists

Skin Contact:

- Wash affected area thoroughly with soap and lukewarm water
- Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse
- Seek medical advice if irritation or sensitization develops

Ingestion:

- Rinse mouth with water
- Do NOT induce vomiting
- Seek medical advice if symptoms occur or if a significant quantity is ingested

SECTION 5: FIREFIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable Extinguishing Media:

- Carbon dioxide (CO₂)
- Dry chemical powder
- Foam
- Water spray (as secondary suppression)

Unsuitable Media:

- Strong water streams directed onto burning liquid (may spread fire)

Special Hazards:

- Carbon monoxide (CO) may be generated in case of fire
- Smoke may contain irritant fumes

Advice for Firefighters:

- Use self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA)
- Use protective equipment appropriate for heat and smoke exposure

SECTION 6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Immediate Actions:

- Prevent entry into drains, surface water, and soil
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes

Containment & Clean-up:

- **Small spills:** Use absorbent material (sand, diatomaceous earth, or commercial absorbent pads)
- **Large spills:** Contain with inert absorbent material; transfer to appropriate container for disposal
- Do not allow to enter sewers or waterways

SECTION 7: HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling:

- Use good manufacturing and industrial hygiene practices
- Keep container tightly closed when not in use
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes during handling
- Wash hands thoroughly after handling

Storage Conditions:

Temperature	5 – 25°C (preferably cool; maximum 30°C)
Light	Keep away from direct sunlight; store in opaque or amber containers
Humidity	Store in dry environment (RH < 70%)
Ventilation	Well-ventilated area
Shelf Life	24 months unopened, in original sealed container
After Opening	Use as soon as practical after opening and keep tightly closed

Incompatible Materials:

- Strong oxidizing agents
- Strong acids and alkalis
- Heavy metal salts (may accelerate oxidative rancidity)

SECTION 8: EXPOSURE CONTROLS AND PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Engineering Controls:

- Adequate ventilation in work areas
- Local exhaust ventilation for bulk handling or heating operations

Respiratory Protection:

Not required under normal ambient conditions. Use appropriate respiratory protection where ventilation is inadequate or where mist/aerosol may be generated.

Eye Protection:

- Protective eyeglasses with side shields for routine handling
- Face shield for bulk handling where splashing may occur

Hand Protection:

- Suitable protective gloves such as nitrile, latex or neoprene

Body Protection:

- Long-sleeved protective clothing or apron as appropriate for the scale of use

Chemical Stability:

Stable under recommended storage and handling conditions.

Conditions to Avoid:

- Extreme heat or extended exposure above 60°C
- Direct sunlight or UV exposure
- Moisture ingress
- Strong oxidizing agents, strong acids, strong alkalis

Hazardous Decomposition Products:

- **Normal conditions:** No hazardous decomposition products expected
